STAR accepts reviews of recently published scholarly monographs in sociology and related fields. Please review the following guidelines before submitting a review to STAR.

- 1. Use the format of the review note if you are reviewing a single book, with a length of 700-900 words.
- 2. For review notes, provide a title for your work that communicates the central theme of the book, followed by the subtitle *A Review of [Book Title]*.
- 3. Use the format of the review essay if you are reviewing two or more books, within the following length guidelines:
 - a. Two or three books: ~1200-1400 words
 - b. Four or more books: ~1500-1800 words
- 4. For review essays, provide a title for your work that communicates the central themes that you explore, followed by the subtitle *A Review Essay*.
- 5. All submissions and correspondence should be in English (British spellings are acceptable). Please follow the formatting guidelines of the <u>American Sociological Association (ASA)</u> for references and in-text citations. Do not include documents other than those listed below.
- 6. All copies must be typed (12-point font) and double spaced on standard letter-sized pages (8½" by 11"); all margins should be exactly 1¼". Footnotes and references do not require double spacing.
- 7. Each submission must include a cover letter, indicating the paper title, author's name, and institutional affiliation, as well as mailing and e-mail addresses for correspondence.
- 8. Each submission must also include a title page, indicating the paper title, author's name, a 200-word abstract, and keywords.
- 9. The text of the manuscript should begin on a separate page following the title page, with a running title-only header on each subsequent page. The author's identifying information should not appear on any page except for the title page of the submission.
- 10. Use headings and subheadings according to ASA guidelines in the text to indicate the organization of your paper.
- 11. References must appear at the end of the manuscript under the top-level heading **REFERENCES**.
